Kitten and Sheriff Projects affirm their support for emerging photographers by honouring Korean photographer Rala Choi, winner of the Grand Prix du jury Photographie 2022 and the Prix du Public of the 37th Festival de Hyères, of which they are partners, with the Blue exhibition at the Sheriff Gallery, in the Marais district of Paris, from 13 January to 25 February 2023.

Rala Choi, a 36-year-old South Korean photographer based in Seoul, works in analogue photography. Self-taught, he is now recognized for the sensitivity of his photographic writing, illuminated by rich and saturated colors. Rala Choi explores the intimate, expresses and communicates his emotions through photography. The artist brings surprising textures to his images, sometimes giving the impression of an oil painting.

Blue reveals his research into his favourite colour. The exhibition features selected photographs by Su kyung OH from his early days to the present, including iconic works from his People's back, Her and Emotion Training series.
