preselected applications. Images must be named and numbered in the desired order of presentation to the jury, as follows: SURNAME_FIRSTNAME-NUMBER from 001 to 050. They must be accompanied by a Word document containing the captions.

- 5. A statement of intent (up to 5,000 characters) explaining the project and highlighting the applicant's motivation, working methodology, technical execution of the subject, along with a budget estimate and projected expenses.**

**EURAZEO PHOTO PRIZE 2026
COMPETITION RULES**

ARTICLE 1 - Preamble

Eurazeo, a *Société européenne* (European company) with a Management Board and a Supervisory Board, whose head office is located 66 rue Pierre Charron, 75008, Paris, registered with the Trade and Companies Register of Paris under number 692030992 (hereinafter referred to as “Eurazeo”), holds a prestigious collection of works by world-renowned photographers such as Sebastião Salgado, Georges Rousse, Nick Brandt and Michael Kenna, among others. This collection is further enriched each year by works from the winners of the annual Photo Prize organised by Eurazeo since 2010. Nearly 130 photographs make up the Eurazeo collection, displayed on the walls of its offices in Paris, London and New York.

ARTICLE 2 – Purpose

The Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 (hereinafter also referred to as the “**The grant**”) aims to develop and bring together diverse approaches to photography.

Theme for the 2026 edition: “**Stories of Europe**”.

The call for applications is open to:

- professional photographers affiliated with the Association for the Management and Social Security of Authors (hereinafter “AGESSA”) or with the Maison des Artistes;
- all professional journalists, without restriction; and
- professional photographers holding a contract in which their profession as a photographer is recognised, such contract being of a commercial or editorial nature;

who wish to carry out an original project aligned with the announced theme. A grant will be awarded to support the research, design and production phases of the selected project.

Any person failing to meet these conditions or refusing to provide proof thereof shall be excluded from the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 and will not be eligible for the grant.

No restrictions based on nationality, geography, or any form of discrimination (language, gender, religion, origin, etc.) apply.

The grant amount must be used exclusively to carry out the project selected as part of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026. Applicants are free to collaborate, at their own expense, with service providers of their choice for the execution of their project. No additional funding will be provided by Eurazeo.

The winner will benefit from:

- funding by Eurazeo of a grant of €20,000;
- reimbursement of travel and accommodation expenses by Eurazeo, subject to supporting documentation. Any expense exceeding €500 must receive Eurazeo’s prior written approval;
- the expertise of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 coordinator in the production of the project, both in terms of content and form, to ensure completion within the agreed timeframe and budget;

- support from Eurazeo in finalising the project, depending on its nature and distribution conditions.

The Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 will be promoted through communication activities including advertising on www.eurazeo.com (hereinafter the “**Website**”), via the press agency 2e Bureau, on social media, and through press releases in art and photography magazines distributed in France. Communication regarding the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 may also be relayed through partners’ networks (websites, blogs and mailing lists).

ARTICLE 3 – Application

Applications are open from 26 May to 13 September 2026 at 11:59 pm (Paris time).

Any application submitted after the closing date will not be considered.

Applications are free of charge. Only one project per applicant will be accepted.

Applicants must submit their application file exclusively via **WeTransfer** to the following address: concoursphotos@eurazeo.com, named as follows: SURNAME_FIRSTNAME, and comprising:

1. A curriculum vitae detailing the applicant’s background and completed work.
2. A full report or a portfolio of at least 50 images, in black and white or colour, exclusively in .JPG format of good quality (minimum 8 megapixels). Eurazeo reserves the right to request the original high-definition files for preselected applications. Images must be named and numbered in the desired order of presentation to the jury, as follows: SURNAME_FIRSTNAME-NUMBER from 001 to 050, and must be accompanied by a Word document containing captions.
3. The completed and signed application form.
4. A statement of intent (maximum 5,000 characters) explaining the project and highlighting motivation, working methodology, technical execution, and including a budget estimate and projected expenses.

Any incomplete or incorrect application, or any application not complying with these rules, will be deemed inadmissible and rejected, without Eurazeo incurring any liability.

Applicants warrant that the works submitted are original, unpublished, and that they hold all exploitation rights. They must also have obtained any necessary authorisations from individuals whose image appears in the photographs.

Without exception, any application received after 13 September 2026 at 11:59 pm (Paris time) will not be considered. Eurazeo reserves the right to archive or destroy all applications. Eurazeo undertakes to respect the confidentiality of applications and not to disclose unsuccessful projects.

Timeline

Application deadline: 13 September 2026 (11:59 pm, Paris time)

Jury meetings: 18 and 21 September 2026

Announcement of the winner: 21 September 2026

Project start: October 2026

ARTICLE 4 – Selection of the Winner

The winner will be selected following a pre-selection process reviewing applications to ensure compliance with Articles 2 and 3.

The jury will shortlist a maximum of five candidates. The five finalists will be invited to present their project to the jury on 21 September 2026, in a 20-minute interview, in person or via videoconference if abroad. They must present their concept, methodology, timeline, and estimated costs.

The jury's decision is final and not subject to appeal. The jury may decide not to award the grant.

The winner agrees to provide regular updates on the progress of the project and to supply Eurazeo with relevant information regarding its execution.

For this purpose, the winner undertakes, in particular, to:

- provide Eurazeo, in accordance with a schedule agreed between the parties and, at a minimum:
 - three interim progress updates (one every two months) covering the artistic, technical and operational progress of the project;
 - a final report relating to the full completion of the project;
- submit a detailed statement of the project's estimated budget, as well as any material updates thereto during the course of its implementation;
- provide, at Eurazeo's request, evidence that the grant has been effectively allocated to the selected project, notably by supplying any relevant supporting documentation (including invoices, quotations, expense records, certificates, statements or any other substantiated evidence).

Eurazeo reserves the right to request any additional information it may deem necessary in order to verify that the project is being carried out in accordance with the commitments undertaken pursuant to these rules.

ARTICLE 5 – Grant Conditions and Allocation

The award of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 grant shall be subject to a strict **obligation of result**.

The grant allocated under the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 must be used exclusively for the purposes of the selected project, as presented by the winner in their application and approved by Eurazeo.

The winner expressly acknowledges that the award of the grant is strictly conditional upon the effective completion of the project, in compliance with:

- the proposed timetable;
- the submitted budget; and

- more generally, all commitments undertaken pursuant to these rules.

The winner undertakes to grant Eurazeo exclusive rights to the completed project until its public presentation organised by Eurazeo at the end of the project. The winner further grants Eurazeo a royalty-free right to use a selection of images from the project solely for the promotion of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026.

The winner shall be required to execute an agreement with Eurazeo to formalise this arrangement. Payment of the first instalment of the grant shall be made upon execution of the agreement, with the balance payable six (6) months thereafter.

Without prejudice to any damages to which Eurazeo may be entitled, Eurazeo reserves the right to require full or partial reimbursement of the grant in the following circumstances:

- failure to complete the project, or partial completion or completion not in accordance with the commitments undertaken;
- use of all or part of the grant for purposes other than those of the selected project;
- failure to provide the required reports or supporting documentation;
- any serious or repeated breach of the obligations set out in these rules.

In the event of any of the above, Eurazeo shall issue a formal notice to the winner, by any means capable of providing proof of receipt, requiring the winner to remedy the breach within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of such notice.

Failing remedy within this period, Eurazeo shall be entitled to request repayment, in a single instalment, of all or part of the sums unduly received, within a maximum period of thirty (30) days following notification of the repayment request.

The obligations set out in this Article constitute essential and determining conditions of Eurazeo's consent. Any breach may result, without prejudice to the other provisions of these rules, in the withdrawal of the benefit of the grant.

As part of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026, the winner undertakes to provide Eurazeo with two (2) or three (3) photographic prints from the project produced as part of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026, selected by Eurazeo, dated and signed (and numbered where applicable), as well as the high-definition files, in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in these rules.

The physical handover of these prints entails the transfer of sole physical ownership of said media to Eurazeo, on a permanent and free-of-charge basis.

Accordingly, Eurazeo shall become the owner of the physical prints and shall be entitled to retain, exhibit, lend, insure, restore or incorporate them into its photographic collection. Eurazeo undertakes to fully respect the winner's moral rights, including:

- the right to attribution;
- the right to the integrity of the work; and
- more generally, the right to respect for the work and the spirit in which it was created.

The selection of prints to be included in the Eurazeo collection shall be made by Eurazeo from among the works comprising the completed project, with due regard for its artistic coherence. The technical specifications of the

prints (format, paper type, signature, numbering and captions) may be determined by mutual agreement between Eurazeo and the winner, in accordance with established fine art photography practices.

ARTICLE 6 – Publicity and Reference to the Winner

By the mere acceptance of these rules, the winner authorises Eurazeo to mention and use, directly or indirectly, their surname, first name, city and country of residence, professional capacity, as well as the photographs resulting from their project, in whole or in part, for the purposes of any advertising or promotional activities and on any medium.

This includes, in particular, all publications, documents, brochures or texts of any kind, whether in printed or electronic form, relating to the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 or referring thereto, in France and abroad.

Such use shall be made without any remuneration, right or benefit of any kind other than the award of the grant, and for the entire duration of the authorised exploitation of the photographs as provided for in Article 11 of these rules.

ARTICLE 7 – Authorisation

Contestants authorize Eurazeo to carry out all necessary verifications of their identity and residence. Any misrepresentation will automatically disqualify the contestant from the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026.

ARTICLE 8 - Amendments to the rules

Eurazeo reserves the right to cancel, postpone, extend, shorten or partially or totally modify the Eurazeo Photo Prize rules if circumstances so require or for any other reason, without having to justify its decision and without incurring liability in any form whatsoever.

Applicants who have submitted an application meeting the criteria set out in these rules prior to their amendment shall be informed of such amendments.

ARTICLE 9 – Processing of Personal Data by Eurazeo

As part of the organisation of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026, Eurazeo, acting as data controller, collects and processes personal data relating to applicants. Failure to provide all mandatory data requested in the application form (indicated by an asterisk) will result in the application not being considered.

In this context, Eurazeo implements personal data processing, in compliance with applicable regulations, solely for the purposes of participation in the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026, communication with applicants and the winner, management of the winner, allocation of the grant, use of the winner's photographs, and to fulfil Eurazeo's legal and regulatory obligations.

The processing carried out in this context is based on the performance of a contract (these rules) with regard to participation in the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026.

The personal data of applicants collected and processed in this context will be retained for the duration of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 for its sole purposes and for the applicable statutory limitation period, with the exception of the winner's data, which will be retained for the period reasonably necessary to achieve the purposes set out above.

The data collected and processed in this context may be disclosed to third-party service providers acting as processors within the meaning of applicable regulations, in order to perform services including hosting, storage, analysis, communication, data processing, database management and IT maintenance.

Such service providers shall act only on Eurazeo's instructions, shall have access to applicants' personal data solely for the performance of these services, and shall be subject to the same obligations of security and confidentiality as Eurazeo.

In accordance with applicable regulations, applicants have the right to access, rectify and erase their personal data, as well as the right to restrict processing and to object to the processing of their personal data. Applicants also have the right to provide Eurazeo with specific instructions regarding the processing of their personal data after their death. To exercise these rights, applicants may send a request by post to:

Finally, applicants have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent data protection authority.

ARTICLE 10 – Liability

Eurazeo's liability shall be strictly limited to the delivery of the grant duly and validly awarded.

Eurazeo shall not be held liable in the event of any malfunction of the Internet network, telephone lines, or receiving equipment preventing the proper conduct of the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026.

Eurazeo reserves the right to cancel all or part of the Photo Grant if it appears that fraud of any kind has occurred in connection with participation in the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 or the designation of the winner. In such circumstances, Eurazeo reserves the right not to award the grant to any fraudulent participant and/or to initiate legal proceedings against the perpetrators of such fraud before the competent courts.

Furthermore, Eurazeo shall not, under any circumstances, be held liable for any issues relating to the transmission or loss of postal or electronic mail. Eurazeo shall not be responsible for any delay, loss or damage resulting from postal or delivery services.

Eurazeo reserves the right to shorten, extend, modify or cancel the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 in the event of force majeure or where circumstances beyond its control so require, without incurring any liability as a result.

ARTICLE 11 – Respect of Third-Party Rights / Media / Use of Winner's Photographs

Applicants shall comply with all applicable legal and regulatory provisions.

Accordingly, applicants shall be responsible, on the one hand, for ensuring that the photographs and the media in which they are incorporated do not infringe any third party's intellectual property rights, image rights, personal rights or privacy, do not contravene public policy or accepted standards of decency, and do not otherwise infringe any third-party rights; and, on the other hand, for ensuring that any captions and texts do not infringe any third party's intellectual property rights (including copyright) or any other third-party rights.

Each applicant represents and warrants that they are the sole and exclusive author of their photographs, captions and texts, and shall indemnify Eurazeo against any claim by a third-party asserting authorship or rights over such elements or their medium. Applicants further represent and warrant that the photographs, captions and texts submitted are original, unpublished (i.e. not reproducing any pre-existing work), do not infringe any of the rights referred to above, and that they hold all exploitation rights in respect thereof. They shall indemnify Eurazeo against any third-party claims in this regard.

Where applicable, applicants shall obtain all necessary authorisations from any third parties who have directly or indirectly contributed to the creation of the photographs, captions or texts, and/or who may claim any rights therein, and shall bear sole responsibility for any related payments.

Applicants acknowledge that participation in the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026 entails the free transfer to Eurazeo of the ownership of the tangible media submitted, without prejudice to their intellectual property rights in the content. Eurazeo shall not be held liable in the event of loss, damage or theft of the media submitted and retained by it.

By the mere acceptance of the grant, the winner grants Eurazeo, on a royalty-free basis, the right to reproduce, represent, translate, adapt, communicate to the public and otherwise exploit all or part of their photographs, captions and texts, if Eurazeo so chooses, directly or indirectly, worldwide, in any form, format and medium, whether now known or hereafter devised, irrespective of the technical process used, in as many copies as it deems appropriate and for any purpose whatsoever, but solely within the scope of the following uses:

- i. Communication relating to the Eurazeo Photo Prize 2026, including its promotional and commercial communication, carried out directly or indirectly by Eurazeo, on any medium whatsoever, including, without limitation, the Website, brochures, leaflets, press releases, posters, etc.;
- ii. Corporate communication by Eurazeo, carried out directly or indirectly, in any format, whether in print or electronic form (including brochures, websites or similar media), in connection with the 2026–2027 period;
- iii. Communication relating to Eurazeo's photographic collection, carried out directly or indirectly, including through the publication of non-commercial catalogues.

Eurazeo is further authorised to exhibit, reproduce, represent and communicate (i) the winner's photographs, captions and texts and (ii) any works or photographs by the winner that may be exhibited, in any location (public or private), by any means and technical processes, whether now known or unknown, regardless of the purpose (commercial, free, advertising, promotional or otherwise). Costs relating to the exhibition of the winner's works shall be borne by Eurazeo.

The winner shall indemnify Eurazeo against any claims, actions or demands brought by any third party arising from the exercise of the rights granted herein, and more generally in connection with any representations,

warranties and undertakings made under these rules, or resulting in Eurazeo being ordered to pay any sum or compensation.

For the purposes of the uses defined above, the winner shall be responsible, where necessary, for obtaining, on behalf of Eurazeo, from any individuals appearing in the photographs, all required authorisations for the free use of their image or any attributes of their personality, for the full duration and scope of the exploitation rights granted above.

The winner shall remain free to use the photographs, captions and texts for personal communication purposes or for exhibitions that do not compete with any exhibitions organised by Eurazeo. However, the winner undertakes to use reasonable efforts to acknowledge the grant awarded by Eurazeo and to refer to Eurazeo in such contexts.

Any commercial exploitation by the winner of the photographs and/or similar photographs produced on the same theme (hereinafter the “Similar Photographs”) shall not prejudice Eurazeo’s reputation or cause it any harm, in particular to its image.

In all circumstances, the winner undertakes not to authorise any third party to use, reproduce or exploit the photographs and/or the Similar Photographs in a manner likely to harm Eurazeo’s reputation or cause any prejudice whatsoever, including to its image, throughout the entire duration of copyright protection as provided for under French and foreign laws and applicable international conventions, including any extensions thereof.

Any use by Eurazeo of the winner’s photographs, captions or texts not expressly provided for in this Article 11 or in these rules shall be subject to a separate rights assignment agreement between the winner and Eurazeo. Eurazeo reserves the right to produce or commission photographic reports and/or interviews with the winner and members of the jury. In such cases, the latter shall authorise Eurazeo, free of charge, to use, in full or in part:

- any such reports featuring the winner or the jury;
- any interviews conducted;
- their name, image and likeness;
- elements of their CV;

for the entire duration of the rights granted under Article 11, in all forms and on all media, whether now known or unknown.

In any event, Eurazeo shall remain entirely free to use or not to use such reports and/or interviews, including any photographs taken of the winner, under the conditions set out above.

ARTICLE 12 – Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

These rules are subject to French law. Contestants are therefore subject to French regulations. Any submission of an application implies full acceptance of these rules.

French shall be the governing language of these rules. In case of discrepancies between the French version and translations in other languages, the French text will prevail.
